

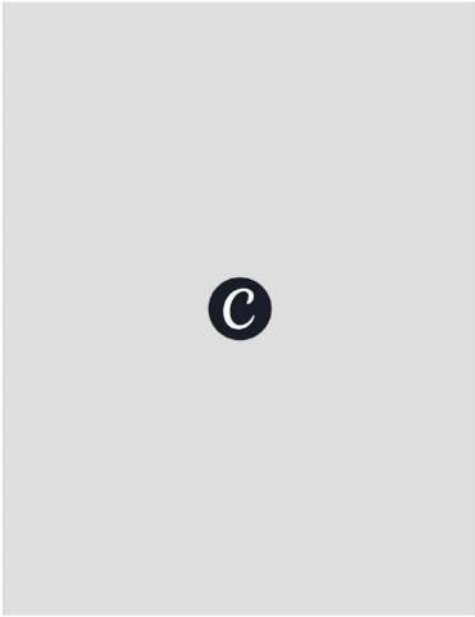

Community Solar for low-to-moderate income residents

According to data from Solstice Power Technologies, 77% of Americans nationwide are ineligible for rooftop solar - therefore lacking access to equitable clean energy savings. Low-to-moderate income residential electricity customers receiving utility service from ComEd can now participate in community solar - and receive savings of up to 20% off of their entire bill with zero investment or on-site solar panels required.

How It Works - Community Solar Explained

Clean Earth Renewables & Solstice Power Technologies provide education, training, onboarding and campaign management support to local community action partners in Chicago who can assist in the implementation of energy savings programs.



Local residents can save money on their utility bill, and **community action partners** designate **solar ambassadors** to educate and enroll the local residents. Subscribers save up to 20% off of their entire bill for enrolling in Solstice's Community Solar Program. For each enrollment, community action partners receive a **sign-up fee of \$25**, and when a local resident subscriber **refers** another customer to sign up, they earn a **subscriber referral fee of \$25**.

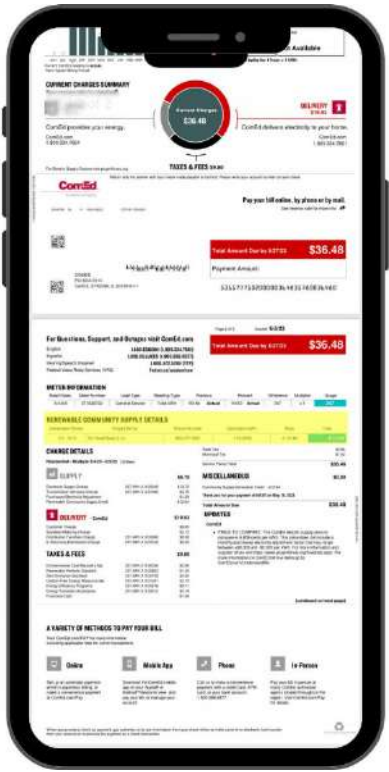

Billing Sample - Understanding Your Savings



Qualified electricity customers who subscribe to a Solstice community solar project will receive an on-bill credit discount as visualized here, of up to **20% off of the entire bill each month**. This program will last for the life of the community solar project, up to 20 years!



There is no cost to join, and no cost to cancel or transfer. Only 2-3 months notice required when moving, and Solstice can transfer your community solar subscription to your new residence if you still qualify - by moving to a new residence where you pay electricity serviced from ComEd!

Eligibility Programs & Documentation

How do local residents in Chicagoland qualify for Community Solar with Solstice?



Qualifying Program		Supporting Documentation
Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)		Award Letter from Illinois Department of Human Services. A SNAP card is not acceptable documentation.
Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)		LIHEAP Award Letter from household's local Community Action Agency or a recent copy of a utility bill showing LIHEAP award.
Illinois Housing Weatherization Assistance Program (IHWA)		IHWAP Award Letter from household's local Community Action Agency.
Medicaid		Benefit letter from Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services or the Illinois Department of Human Services OR Medical Card (front and back)
* This is an individual benefit. Other members of the household must provide additional documentation of income-eligibility. Members of the household can use documentation from different income-eligible programs or utilized Option 2 or Option 3.

Who is Solstice?

Solstice is a community solar technology platform providing on-bill credit savings to utility customers that subscribe to locally integrated community solar projects. Solstice manages the billing platform of the community solar program for project developers and end-customers, aka **community solar subscribers!**



Benefit from solar without the cost

When you enroll in community solar, you reserve a share of panels at a nearby solar garden. Your share's production earns you credits on your electric bills that bring down your costs.



Accessible

Affordable

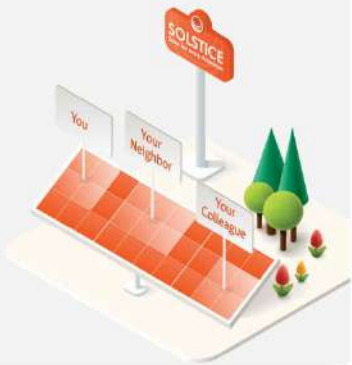
There are no added costs to join or cancel, no "gotcha" moments, and no risk of paying more than you would without solar. Just monthly savings.
